

HLCCA Conference Consignment Sale Info

The consignment sale is a popular part of the annual HLCCA Conference. More than 600 items, brought by attendees, are available for sale.

We're making some changes this year, with more details to come, but here are the things you need to know now!

- Each conference attendee can bring up to 20 items for consignment. Coming as a couple? You can each bring 20 items.
- You can consign HLC/FTC dishes and related items in good condition. However, we cannot accept:
 - Any P86 Fiesta with third-party decorations (done outside the factory) or rogue items
 - Any items currently in production by FTC (available for sale on the website or outlet)
 - Any HLCCA Conference exclusives from the past five conferences (2018 to present)
- If you'd like to have items in the consignment sale, please email Kathy Holley (Kathy.holley@hlcca.org) by May 15. She will put your name on the list and assign you item numbers.
- You will submit a list of your items with the price you want to charge by June 2.
- You will be assigned a time on Friday afternoon to unpack your items and together we will check them in and attach the price tags.
- The consignment sale will be held on Saturday from 9 a.m. to noon. Items that did not sell must be picked up between 12:30 and 1:30 Saturday afternoon.
- You will receive a check for all items sold (minus 10% to HLCCA) a couple of weeks after conference.

You make some money and clear space for new dishes, customers find items they want, and the HLCCA benefits, too—everybody wins!
